3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To construct, maintain, or support community halls, training centres, libraries, sanitation facilities, and other infrastructure for community development.
2. To collaborate with government schemes for developing rural and urban infrastructure.
3. To promote financial literacy, savings culture, banking awareness and empowerment among youth, women and rural communities.
4. To assist individuals in accessing government welfare schemes, subsidies, and financial inclusion programmes.
5. To collaborate with government bodies, NGOs, academic institutions, corporate wings, and international organizations for implementing welfare and development projects.
6. To raise funds, grants, donations and CSR support for social welfare activities while maintaining full transparency.
7. To promote animal welfare by supporting shelters, conducting vaccination drives, and raising awareness against cruelty.
8. To aid injured, abandoned, or at-risk animals

and promote adoption programmes.

9. To organize sports tournaments, fitness programmes, yoga camps, health awareness activities, and recreational events.

10. To support young sportspersons by providing resources, mentorship, and training support.

11. To promote cleanliness, hygiene and sanitation through awareness campaigns, community drives, school programmes, and public participation initiatives.

12. To organize Swachhata Abhiyan, waste-collection drives, street cleaning initiatives, and village/town cleanliness programmes.

13. To support and promote construction of toilets, waste-segregation systems, drainage improvements, and solid-waste management practices.

14. To collaborate with government missions such as Swachh Bharat Mission, local bodies and other agencies to improve environmental sanitation and public health.

15. To educate communities about proper waste disposal, recycling, plastic-free initiatives, and maintaining clean surroundings.

16. To promote education and literacy by establishing, running, supporting, maintaining, or assisting in the setting up of schools, colleges, universities, libraries, research centres, hostels, coaching institutes, training centres, vocational and technical education centres, e-learning platforms, adult education programmes, special education for differently abled persons, and to provide scholarships, learning material, digital education tools and other support to deserving students.

17. To construct, establish and operate dharamshalas, rest houses, and facilities for

patients, attendants and pilgrims and to undertake, promote and support research, training and development in the fields of Ayurveda, yoga therapy, naturopathy and alternative medicine.

18. To guide, counsel and support students for higher education in India and abroad by providing genuine and affordable counselling services, scholarship assistance, and awareness programs without profit motive.

19. To support students throughout their academic journey including training, internship, research, skill development, and job placement to help them build a successful career.

20. To establish and operate community kitchens, food banks, and feeding programs to ensure access to safe, nutritious, and hygienic food for needy persons..

21. To conduct training programs, workshops, seminars and awareness drives for unemployed youth, women, and weaker sections of society to enable them to become self-reliant and to provide assistance, guidance and resources for setting up small scale businesses, cottage industries, handicrafts, and service-oriented enterprises.

22. To promote healthcare, sanitation and public health by establishing, supporting, maintaining or assisting hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, dispensaries, diagnostic centres, telemedicine facilities, blood banks, health awareness programmes, mobile health vans, maternity and child care centres, vaccination camps, counselling centres, yoga and naturopathy camps, mental health initiatives, and to undertake projects in the areas.

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To promote environmental protection,

conservation and sustainable development by undertaking projects in afforestation, biodiversity conservation, water harvesting, watershed management, waste management, plastic reduction, climate change mitigation, energy conservation, promotion of renewable energy sources, organic farming, sustainable agriculture practices, animal welfare, wildlife conservation, and preservation of ecological balance.

2. To promote art, culture, heritage and sports by supporting and organising cultural events, exhibitions, museums, heritage preservation projects, traditional art and craft promotion, music, dance, theatre, literature, film and folk art, as well as to encourage and promote sports, physical education, training academies, fitness programmes, and sports competitions at local, national and international levels.

3. To provide relief and assistance during natural calamities, disasters and emergencies such as floods, droughts, earthquakes, pandemics, epidemics, cyclones, fires, and accidents, by arranging food, medical aid, temporary shelters, clothing, education, rehabilitation programmes, counselling and other relief measures for affected people.

4. To promote rural and urban development by facilitating community development projects, livelihood generation, self-employment training, skill development workshops, women empowerment initiatives, awareness on government schemes, social enterprises, rural infrastructure development (such as schools, sanitation, drinking water facilities), and holistic development of weaker communities.

5. To promote research, innovation and knowledge sharing in the fields of education, environment, health, agriculture, science, technology, social development, and sustainable practices, and to establish or support research centres, innovation hubs, think-tanks, conferences, workshops, training programmes, and knowledge-sharing platforms for the benefit of society.

6. To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise any movable or immovable property and any rights or privileges which the company may deem necessary convenient for the main business of the company.

7. To import, buy, exchange all kinds of plant machinery, apparatus, tools and things, necessary for carrying on the main business of the company.

8. To vest any movable or immovable property, rights or interests acquired by or received or belonging to the company, in any person or persons or company on behalf of or for the benefit of the company and with or without any declared trust in favour of the company.

9. To purchase or otherwise acquire, construct, carry out, equip, maintain, alter, improve, develop, manage, work, and control factories, warehouses workshop, sheds, dwellings, offices, shops, stores, buildings, electric and electronic goods/equipments, all other kinds of works, machinery, apparatus, labour lines, houses and such other works and conveniences necessary for carrying on the main business of the company.

10. To acquire and takeover the whole or any part of the business, goodwill, trademarks, properties and liabilities of any person or persons, firms, companies or undertake other existing or new,

engaged in or carrying or proposing to carry on the main business which the company is authorized to carry on and possessed of any property or rights suitable for the main business of the company and to pay for the same either in cash or in shares or partly in cash and partly in shares or by any other kind of arrangement.

11. To undertake or promote scientific research relating to any business or class of business in which the company is engaged in.

12. To negotiate and enter into agreements and contracts with Indian and foreign individuals, companies, corporation and such other organizations for technical, or any other assistance for carrying on all or any of the main objects of the company or for the purpose of activating research and development of projects on the basis of know-how, or technical collaboration and acquire necessary formulae and patent rights for furthering the main objects of the company.

13. To amalgamate with any other such company or companies having all or any objects similar to the objects of this company in any manner whether with or without process of liquidation of that company.

14. Subject to the companies act, for the time being in force, to undertake or take part in the formation, supervision or control of the main business or operations of any person firm, body corporate, association, undertaking carrying on the main business of the company.

15. To apply for, obtain, purchase or otherwise acquire prolong and renew any patents, patent rights, brevets de invention, processes, scientific technical or such other assistance of all types, process know- how such other, information, designs, patents, copyrights, trademarks, licences,

concessions and rights or benefits, conferring an exclusive or non-exclusive or limited or right or use thereof, which may seem capable if being used for or in connection with the main objects of the company or the acquisition of which may seem directly for indirectly to benefit the company on payment of any fee, royalty or such other consideration of all type and to use, exercise or develop the same or grant licences in respect thereof and to spend money in experimenting, upon, testing or improving any such patents, inventions, rights or concessions.

16. To apply for and obtain any orders, charter, privilege concession, licence or authorisation from any government, state or such other authority for enabling the company to carry on its main objects into effect or for extending any of the powers, of the company or for effecting any modification of the constitution of the company or for any other such purpose which may seem expedient and to oppose any proceedings or applications which may seem directly or indirectly to prejudice the interest of the company.

17. To enter into any arrangements with any government or authorities or any persons or companies that may seem conducive to the main objects of the company or any of them and to obtain from any such government, authority, person or any company rights, charters, contracts, licences and concessions which the company may obtain and to carry out, exercise and comply therewith.

18. To procure the company to be registered or recognised in or under the laws of any place outside India and to do all acts necessary for carrying on in any foreign country the main business of the company.

19. To draw, make, accept, discount, execute and issue bills

of exchange, promissory notes, bills of lading. Warrants, debentures and such other negotiable or transferable instruments or securities of all types and to open bank accounts and to operate the same in the ordinary course of business.

20. To undertake and execute any trusts, the undertaking of which may seem to the company beneficial either gratuitously or otherwise in connection with the main business of the company.

21. To establish or promote or concur in establishing or promoting any company, for the purpose of acquiring all or any of the properties, rights and liabilities of the company.

22. To mortgage, lease, exchange, grant licence and other rights, manage, develop or dispose of undertaking.

Investments, assets and rights of the company or any part thereof for such consideration as may be conducive to the main business of the company.

23. To promote animal birth control programs (ABC), vaccination, and sterilization of stray animals in collaboration with local authorities.

24. To promote and protect human rights including civil, political, economic, social, and cultural rights as enshrined in the Constitution of India and international human rights instruments.

25. To create awareness and educate citizens about their fundamental rights and duties through workshops, seminars, training programs, publications, and campaigns.

26. To provide legal aid, counselling, and support to victims of human rights violations, marginalized communities, and other vulnerable groups.

27. To conduct research, documentation, and advocacy on issues related to human rights, equality, non-

discrimination, and social justice.

28. To collaborate with government agencies, NGOs, academic institutions, and international bodies for promoting and safeguarding human rights in India.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company
